



### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### Dryness to Life - I will put my spirit in you

### Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ:

Dear brothers and sisters, the Sunday message was delivered under the topic 'Drvness to Life' meditating the verse Ezekiel 37:14 "I will put my spirit in you and you shall live". Lets have a deeper thought about reasons of dryness in one's life. There might be many reasons but the Holy Spirit to our congregation revealed the following - the lack of relationship with God, not yielding to the Holy Spirit, not rooted in the Word of God, attitude of impenitence and not enjoying the presence of God. I want to be very clear about the fact it is not God's will for us to be lifeless, so he pours the spirit of supplication along with spirit of grace as stated in Zechariah 12-10. Because only through the spirit of supplication one would get the light and revelation on what to pray and request God what we need. I can confidently reinstate that there are many characters in Bible who have prayed with spirit of supplication and have received God's glory, to name some are King Hezekiah in 2Kings 20:1-5, Hannah in 1Samuel1: 10-12; 17; 27. It is wise to ask God that I have a situation and how you would like me to supplicate this- Ephesians 6-8 "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit; being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints". And God does not push our prayers if presented in spirit of supplication which is revealed by him and is confirmed by the verse Psalms 6:9.

God wants to clothe us with sinews, flesh and skin by giving us the spirit of hearing the Word, keeping the Word and transforming through and by Word. His Word is our daily manna; strive to receive it at any cost. When Word is rooted Jesus Christ will manifest himself in us, no longer us but he will take control of our lives. Jairus situation in Bible is an apt example. Jairus never left Jesus side even when he received the bad news, and he kept trusting in the word of faith/hope that Jesus promised him" Do not be afraid; just believe" and his daughter was saved. Stay with him who blesses you with LIFE and travel with Word of GOD.

Let us be practical and look at the most common problems that we face day to day, it is within our family relationships, especially between spouses. Avoid dryness in family relationship by not demanding but minister in family with love according to scripture 2 Timothy 1:7" For God has given us the Spirit of love and not given us the Spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of sound mind" and Galatians 5:13-15. Conditional love based relationship cannot sustain family relationships but one must love each other as he loves us.

Conclusion- Finally my dear brothers and sisters, God is looking for the thirst in us to pray with spirit of supplication, thirst to turn our dryness in life through his Word and thirst to hold on to Spirit of Love. If one thirsts for these, he is willing to pour his spirit to make you live as promised in Isaiah 44: 3 "For I will pour water on him who is thirsty". Now that God has given us his spirit we will not act by our own thoughts and actions, but we will live, stand, and become exceedingly great army with him, with our church and family.

# Did you Know?? SOME FACTS ABOUT Adam, Eve and Eden

**Adam was named after the elements** he was created from. Bible explains that God created the first man, who he called Adam, from mere dust. 'Adamah' in Hebrew means earth/ soil.

Adam and Eve did not undergo biological birth but God raised the former from the earth's dust (Psalm 139:15) from whose body He made the latter (Genesis 2:21-22

Initially, Adam named his wife "women". He named her Eve after he ate the fruit from the tree of knowledge.

**Eve is not a Hebrew word**. It is an English word evolved from the word in Hebrew "Chavah". The name Eve means 'to give life'.

Adam lived to 930 years old! It is unknown when Eve died.

The forbidden fruit might not have been an apple. A Latin translation, which appeared in the fourth century AD, first used the word "malum" when describing the fruit of tree of knowledge. 'Malum' in Latin is apple.
