Journey of Budding Church to a Big Family



Our calling towards Christ ministry started since Aug 2005. When we knew a call to ministry is essentially a call to serve God, His Gospel, His people, and His world, it was God's plan to bring us as a missionary to Southampton. This calling of God was confirmed through the word Isaiah 41:8-10 and was reiterated through another word 2 Samuel 7:16

We are now so glad that there are 2 churches established in South coast out from our church. Throughout these years we have moved on from various rented places to gather and worship and now we gather every Sundays at "Lordswood Community Centre" which is in Lordswood, Southampton.

Now we have almost 70 to 75 members including kids who are eagerly participating in all church activities to worship HIM, glorify HIM and extend HIS kingdom. Being a Pastor I truly look forward to what God has planned for us and for the ministry.



Since the ministry was started, I'm being a pastor's helpmate longed for bringing kids towards HIS ministry. Though I had this thirst towards kids' ministry I didn't have any idea of implementing the plan, but His grace carried me to help kids grow in Christ.

Now God has enlarged our kids group to 30 who are in various groups like Beginner 1 (4-6 years), Beginner 2 (7-9 years), Junior (13-15 years). We do have almost 5 teachers who are leading our kids to expand HIS ministry. Our teachers teach our children through zoom every Fridays 4:30 to 6:00 pm and at every gathering.

Here at our gatherings, we praise and worship God, teach them Bible stories, teach them how to pray for others. Each kids share their testimony to show what God has done in their daily lives, memorize and recite Bible verses. Kids within their capability actively participate in any given work that is towards HIS ministry.

We as a teacher of kid's ministry are happy to hear testimony from parents who share telling their kids can differentiate good and evil. This has made us feel like that the Lord has moved in our kid's lives. He has answered prayers beyond anything we could have imagined. Now as a parent, teachers of kid's ministry be faithful to declare that... (Psalm 78: 4-7) ... "We will not hide them from their children we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, HIS power, and the wonders he has done....... so that they should set their hope in God".

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

UNDERSTANDING HEART

Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ:

1 Chronicles 22:12

May the LORD give you discretion and understanding when he puts you in command over Israel, so that you may keep the law of the LORD your God. Here David imparts statutes to Solomon emphasizing the importance of wisdom, understanding and the responsibility towards Israel. The significance of the heart as a vital organ becomes evident as God seeks the heart of His people stressing their love for Him with at most sincerity which is a very first important commandment that God gave us Deuteronomy 6:4 Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

Despite God's emphasize on understanding, warns about the deceitfulness of the heart as in Jeremiah (17:9-10). David, acknowledging this prays for a purified heart in Psalms (51:10). Jesus, in Matthew 5:8, underscores that only those with pure heart can truly perceive God.

Reflecting on Jesus teachings in parables (Matthew 16:9; Matthew 24:29), His disciples were puzzled. Jesus reproached their lack of understanding (Matthew 15:16 Are you still without understanding?), revealing God's desire for comprehension among His children.

Understanding involves knowledge's proper application, rooted in the fear of the Lord. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding (Proverbs 9:10). This makes clear that understanding is in and with God.

Consequences of not understanding:

Failure to grasp God's teachings leads to the following:

- 1. God's presence is away Adam and Eve sinned and hid themselves from God's presence (Genesis 3:8-10).
- Blessing is away Moab and Ammon became cursed because of Lot being unaware of what happened (Genesis 19:33-35).
- 3. Repentance is away –The words in Matthew 13:15 "and I would heal them," indicates that understanding and repentance bring about spiritual healing and reconciliation with God. Therefore, the inability or unwillingness to understand creates a significant barrier between individuals and God, reinforcing the idea that comprehension and receptivity to spiritual truths are crucial for a meaningful connection with the God.
- Word is taken away The parable of the sower (Matthew 13:13-15) elucidates that without understanding, the evil one snatches away God's word.
- 5. Brightness is away Psalm 82:5 states lack knowledge and understanding. The verse "They do not know, nor do they understand" suggests a deficiency in wisdom or discernment. The metaphor "They walk about in darkness" shows a state of spiritual or intellectual blindness, a lack of guidance or moral clarity.

God Seeks understanding individuals: THE LORD LOOKS DOWN UPON MEN AND CHILDREN IF THERE IS ANY WHO UNDERSTANDS GOD (Psalms 14: 2, 3).

In order to gain understanding it is essential to keep the following things in mind:

- Through His presence Acquiring understanding is 1. through God's presence (Proverbs 8:14) ask for it: it seems like you're emphasizing the importance of seeking wisdom and understanding through prayer, drawing inspiration from the biblical story of David and Solomon 1 Chronicles 22:12. The idea is that, rather than solely asking for material wealth or physical strength, it is valuable to seek understanding and wisdom, as these qualities enable one to apply knowledge effectively. Teaching children the importance of prayer for understanding aligns with the idea of instilling spiritual values and virtues from a young age, encouraging them to seek not only knowledge but also the wisdom to use it responsibly. Enjoy understanding: It is indeed accurate that true clarity dawns upon us when we comprehend deeply, resonating within our hearts. In our life's journey, we often prioritize utilitarian values, yet this emphasis is destined to evolve. Realizing genuine happiness necessitates a departure from the narrow focus on utility alone. Our persistent lack of understanding has led us down diverse paths. It is crucial to recognize that the magnitude of one's existence is a divine choice. Embracing the understanding of our limitations is the gateway to true joy. Example: Drawing inspiration from biblical figures, we find Moses, whose emphasis on the 'promiser' outweighed the allure of the promised destination (Exodus 33:15). He declared his unwillingness to proceed if the promiser's presence didn't accompany them. Similarly, David, a renowned king, grasped the profound truth that eternal happiness emanates from God's presence (Psalms 84:2, 3, 10).
- 2. Through His Precepts: "In Psalms 119:104, the profound declaration echoes: I gain understanding from your precepts; therefore, I hate every wrong path.' (Amen!) Isaiah 28:9;26 assures us that God will instruct and enlighten us. Psalms 119:105 beautifully illustrates, Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. Additionally, Psalms 119:130 emphasizes the illuminating power of God's words: 'The entrance of Your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.' May we find wisdom and clarity through these divine teachings.
- 3. Through His Promiser: 1 Corinthians 2:12 states that the Holy Spirit is the promise of the Father and the Son (Acts 1:5; John 14:16). The advice is to submit to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, as it will refine us like gold during testing. Job, despite not fully understanding, trusted that God knew (Job 23:8-10), and the love of Christ ensures an inseparable connection (Romans 8:36). Job 32:8 emphasizes the spirit in man and the understanding from the Almighty's breath.

Ultimately, understanding God's love surpasses all. Life begins with our plans but ends with understanding that only God's plan prevails. In teaching our children, we should emphasize praying for understanding, recognizing it as a gift from God. May we seek, pray for, and cherish an understanding heart. Amen.

Did you Know?? SOME FACTS ABOUT CHRIST'S BIRTH

Mary Was Virgin

"Behold, the virgin shall be with child and give birth to a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel"—which, when translated, means, "God with us." – <u>Matthew 1:23</u>

Jesus Was Born in the Same Village as King David

"He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing it and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever" - **Isaiah. 9:7**

Jesus Birth Came after 400 Years of Silence from God

During this 400-year period, several nations overtake Israel. Israel successfully rebels against some (i.e., the Maccabean revolt) but by the time Jesus arrives, Romans had occupied Israel. Like their 400 years in Egypt, the Israelites wanted a Saviour. No wonder they clamoured for Jesus to topple Rome, just as the Red Sea had toppled the Egyptians.

Jesus Was Probably Not Born in December

While Christmas has been celebrated on December 25 for nearly 1700 years, Jesus was not actually born in December. In fact, he was not born in winter at all! In the year 336 AD Emperor Constantine established Christmas to be on the winter solstice, which is December 25. However, Jesus most likely had a spring birth, thanks to the mention in **Luke 2** of shepherds abiding in their fields. During springtime, sheep gave birth to lambs, hence why they would stay out at night as well in case a night birth occurred.

The Wise Men Were Not There

Many of you might have heard that the wise men did not appear during the night of Jesus' birth, no matter what nativity scenes may try to tell you. In fact, it took them about two years to make the trek from their homeland to Judea, when they approached Herod. This means they did not see Jesus until he'd reached the age of two. Hence why Herod tries to kill children around that age.

The wise men were pagan priests.

The Magi mentioned in the Gospel of Matthew were astrologers from a priestly class in the land of Persia (Iran), skilled in interpreting omens, dreams, and stars. In the Old Testament, Daniel spent 70 years exiled among magi from the east. These wise men may have travelled well over 1,000 miles by camel caravan to see the newborn King of the Jews. "In those days, a new star in the sky was often believed to herald the birth of a significant person in the land over which the star had shone".

Gifts Of Magi Were PROPHETIC

- The gold is a symbol of Christ's kingship on earth.
- The frankincense is a symbol of Christ's deity.
- The myrrh as a symbol of death. (Myrrh was traditionally used as an embalming oil)

Dreams Played Key Role in Protecting JESUS

And having been warned [by God] in a dream not to go back to Herod, the magi left for their own country by another way. - <u>Matthew 2:12</u>
